THE CITY OF TUTTLE COUNCIL MEMBERS MET IN REGULAR WORKSHOP SESSION ON **APRIL 26, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.** IN THE TUTTLE CITY HALL BUILDING LOCATED AT 221 W. MAIN STREET

CALL TO ORDER McLeroy called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION and QUESTIONS regarding annual councilmember training presented by Bill Tackett from Oklahoma Municipal Assurance Group.

Tackett presented councilmember training. He discussed the book “The Infinite Game” and how it applies to city government.

He suggested reviewing the City Council Handbook annually. He asked how you work and what do you pay attention to. Tackett stated cities exist to increase public safety and facilitate commerce. The three duties of the City Council are the duty of care, obedience and loyalty. He stated the most scarce resource is time.

Tackett stated only four things should be on the agenda. The future, culture/policies, monitoring results and decisions that exceed the authority granted. He stated the Council should set policies that pre-approve City Manager emergency spending.

Hughes presented the Council monitors projects. Dickson stated the Council monitors the budget and sales tax.

Tackett stated the City should be run like a business and should be getting a return on the business and equity. He asked if the Council is staff led or Council led.

Motion was made by Dickson, seconded by Hughes, at 6:58 p.m. to extend the meeting until 7:30 p.m. Motion carried as follows:
