

**SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE**

Under and by virtue of Section 27 of Article X, of the Oklahoma Constitution and the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma, and Acts complementary, supplementary, and enacted pursuant thereto, and Resolution No. 2019-11 dated September 9, 2019, authorizing the calling of an election on the proposition hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Tuttle, Oklahoma, hereby call a special election and give notice thereof to be held in the City of Tuttle, Oklahoma, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2019, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters in said City the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Shall the City of Tuttle, State of Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing general obligation bonds in the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) to provide funds for the purpose of acquiring and/or constructing and furnishing and equipping a public safety facility for the City of Tuttle, Oklahoma, all to be owned exclusively by said City, to be completed with or without the use of other funds, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed ten percent (10%) per annum, payable semi-annually, and to become due serially within twenty-five (25) years from their date?

The voting machines or devices used at said election shall set out the proposition as above set forth and shall also contain the words:

YES – FOR THE ABOVE PROPOSITION

NO – AGAINST THE ABOVE PROPOSITION

The specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid bonds shall be expended, which may be accomplished through participation with other governmental agencies and others, and which may be accomplished in phases, and the dollar amounts for each project including applicable costs of issuance shall be as follows:

Acquisition and/or construction and furnishing and equipping of a public safety facility to be located in Tuttle, Oklahoma, including related internal and/or external facility improvements. Said public safety facility will include police department facilities and will potentially also include associated 911 dispatch and communication services related to public safety. \$2,000,000

(100% of \$2,000,000)

That only the registered, qualified voters of the City of Tuttle, Oklahoma, may vote upon the proposition as above set forth.

The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock a.m. and shall remain open continuously until and be closed at 7:00 o'clock p.m.

Such election shall be conducted by those precinct officers designated by the County Election Board of Grady County, Oklahoma, which officers shall also act as counters and certify the results thereof as required by law.
